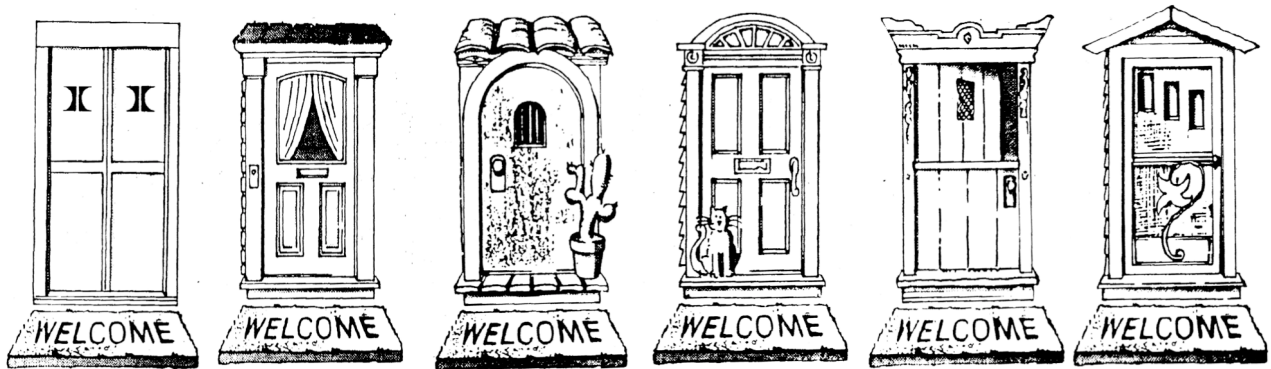


What's Behind This Door?

Singing Time Activity



Instructions:

1. Print "Door" pictures onto heavy cardstock paper. (Color if Desired)
2. Trim the Door Pictures leaving a sturdy border for a frame.
3. Using an Exacto blade, cut along the inner door outline on three sides so that the door will open, but stay connected to picture. Fold the "hinge" side carefully so that it will open outward.
4. Using a metal brad, create a doorknob so that by turning the bent arms of the brad, the door will open and shut, but stay closed when not in use.
5. Arrange the "Doors" onto bulletin board, white board, or magnetic chalkboard using tape, sticky tack, or magnets.
6. Conceal behind each door something interesting for the children to find as they are called upon.
7. For a more permanent display, use foam core board as a backing for the "Doors."

Things to conceal behind the "Doors":

1. Primary Song Titles
2. Scripture References
3. Small Picture Clues
4. Questions pertaining to the theme or lesson of the day.
5. Physical Challenge such as conducting the music or playing an instrument or drawing clues with chalk or dry erase marker or holding a visual aid
